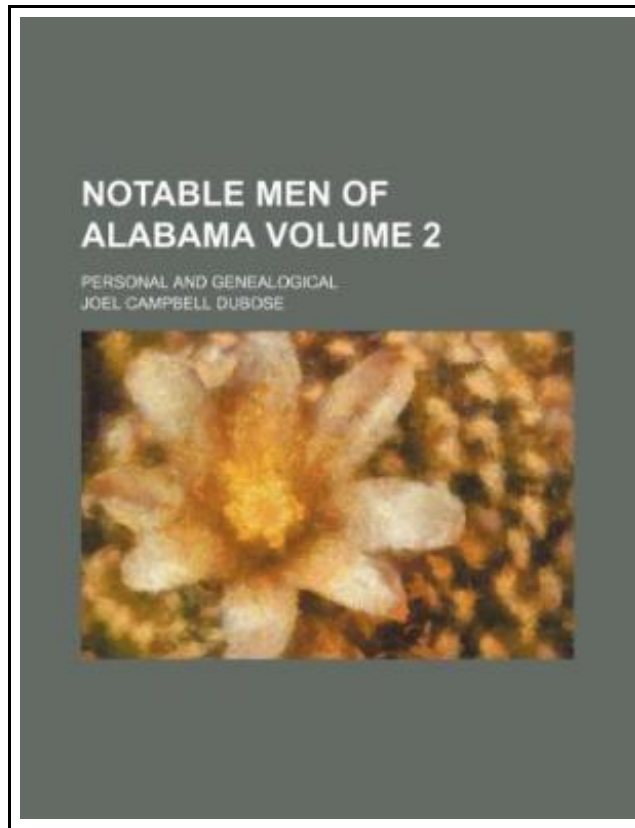

Comstock married Sophia Adelaide, daughter of Frederick P. Nardin, a Frenchman whose father came to this country to keep his sons from having to serve in Napoleons armies. One of these sons is still living, at Vandalia, Mo. , at the advanced age of nearly one hundred years. Rev. O. E. Comstock is the eldest of three children. His sister, Helena A. , now Mrs. Thomas Wheeler, resides in Louisville, Ky. , where his mother is still living; and his brother, William, is a car inspector in Kentucky. Mr. Comstock was educated in the public schools of Louisville, afterward attending the Southern Baptist Theological seminary of that city, but owing to ill health did not complete the course. In 1889 he came South for his health and soon became interested in mission work on Furnace Hill, at the same time being employed in the job printing department of the Sheffield Enterprise. He remained with this paper until 1890, when he formed a partnership, the firm being known as Comstock and Baldwin, and started the publication of The Reaper in March, 1891. In July, 1902, he became the sole proprietor and enlarged it from time to time, until it is now a six-column folio, which was pronounced the model paper by the State Press association, and is a widely quoted paper. As a printer he has taken several prizes in job work and display advertising, showing him to be well up in his...
